The Academy provides an intensive educational environment where participants gain in-depth knowledge on various aspects of the law of the sea, including international maritime regulations, maritime dispute resolution, and the legal frameworks governing maritime resources.

The Academy emphasizes practical and theoretical approaches, combining expert lectures with case studies, simulations, and workshops. It attracts a diverse group of participants, including lawyers, diplomats, researchers, and government officials, providing a platform for networking and collaboration on maritime legal issues.

In addition to its academic program, the Law of the Sea Academy engages with international organizations, law firms, and governmental bodies to address current challenges in maritime law and to promote legal cooperation in the field.
